



Questioning the 'Voices' Activity

Outcomes:

- Know the climate change views of peers in India, Kenya and the UK
- Young people to pose questions about climate change directly to peers in India and Kenya

Warm up:

Climate change has become a growing challenge for people all over the world. Finding out about the issues and solutions that others have taken around the world can inspire local action in the school community.

Here are links to several resources that show real-life situations in India and Kenya, and how young people are responding to them. Select one or two to stimulate initial discussion in your groups.

1. **Nakuru, Kenya** - Nakuru is the 4th largest town in Kenya and is surrounded by the National Park. The growing population of the town is leading to more and more pollution. Show one of the two Nakuru videos linked here and ask students to note down the problems faced and the actions people are taking.

2. **International Climate Challenge (ICC), Kenya** - Look at the 'Freeze the Ice' newsletter produced by the ICC team and young people across Kenya. It describes some of the inspiring actions that Kenyan students are taking on climate change. Ask your students to note down specific local problems and how they are being addressed by teams of young people in schools in Kenya. 3. **EVS Project India** - Show the video of an ICC project led by young people in a college in Mumbai, India. Ask students to think about the problems that these young people have identified and what they have chosen to do to raise awareness of these problems.

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4. **Hear Our Voices** - Show the students some of the 1000 Voices from India, Kenya and the UK in the Gallery on the ICC website. If you are having problems accessing the 'Voices' from your school computer use the word attachments. Use a range of pictures and views to stimulate discussion e.g.:

India: Children's Academy Asha Nagar Mumbai, Vidya Valley School, DAV School

Kenya: Garissa School (pictures), Nakuru Boys High School, Precious Blood Girls

U.K.: Upton-by-Chester High School, Desborough School, St. Columbs College
